Subject: Executive Director's Report (December 12, 2022 – January 6, 2023)

#### **Program Management**

• **Program Director meeting** held on January 6th. Agenda included:

- o Review of current Facilities Calendar in Sharepoint with Patrick Kilkenny
  - Limitations such as: can only view by building; not enough location options
  - The <u>Committee meetings calendar</u> that was available behind the member wall will be resurrected for 2023 and managed by Jen. This was discontinued in 2022 due to the Admin staffing shortage.
  - Julia has been diligent about watching for scheduling conflicts and proactive about offering alternatives
- The Program Directors agreed to work together to put on "Woods Walk II" on Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>. The walk will begin at 4:30 and participants may join the Sam Spayde Hot Dog Roast afterwards.
- Another Program "scheduling" meeting is planned for January 23rd
  - Program Directors, Patrick and Zach will review what is on our consolidated Facilities
     Calendar for the 8-week Assembly Season for programs.
    - As a team, we will confirm that Zach may move forward with the Facilities Calendar data for publication in the Summer Program.
      - Zach is asking for all entries for Bay View's printed Summer Program to be submitted by the end of January.

#### • Education program administration

 Drafted an "Education Guest Agreement" for unique types of guests coming to Bay View via Education programming.

#### Performing Arts

- Vespers ticket sales are at \$5,500, which is \$1,350 ahead of last year at this time. This was the
  first time that the Music Festival offered an online viewing of highlights from prior season
  Vesper performances. We are evaluating whether to offer a similar video next year before
  Christmas again.
  - A Valentine promotion for discounted Vesper tickets will be launched later this month.
     This is the last opportunity to purchase tickets at a discount for 2023.

### Facilities Calendar software upgrade – from Sharepoint to Skedda
