Woods Walk II will occur on Monday, July 3rd beginning at 4:30 p.m. Just like last year, you are welcome to support our Recreation program and eat at the Sam Spade Hot Dog Roast after touring Bay View Woods.

The 2023 Woods Walk will use last year’s event as a model. This year’s event will again appeal to people of all generations and will be open to the public. It will blend creative story-telling, art, education, environmental conservation, and music that is inspired by, focused on, and set in our Bay View woodland environment.

At the Mid-winter meeting, your Board of Trustees approved **landscape improvement projects** for central campus. New landscaping will be installed around two significant buildings: Crouse Chapel and Hall Auditorium this spring. Many special services and events occur at these locations. Social spaces exist both inside and outside the chapel and the auditorium where members and visitors interact and create cherished memories.

Our landscape architect, Beckett and Raeder created sustainable designs that complement each building and each location on campus. The goal is to offer joyful environments around each building that will enrich the quality of an individual’s overall experience at Bay View Association.

The new landscape designs reduce grounds maintenance work related to hand mowing and minimize annual weeding and other plant maintenance done by grounds staff and volunteers. Irrigation around the chapel will be reconfigured to prevent further damage to the building exterior. A soaker hose/timer irrigation system will utilize existing water connections at Hall Auditorium. Thus, efficient use of water will occur.

As we approach our 150th Jubilee, the beautiful landscaping around Wade, Hall Auditorium, and Crouse Chapel will be flourishing and reflect our Association’s pride in preserving its National Historic Landmark that upholds treasured Chautauqua traditions.

In closing, I look forward to seeing you in your neighborhoods this summer. It is such a pleasure to go for walks in Bay View. If you see me out and about, I hope that we can take a moment to enjoy each other’s company.
